Uniform Policy

The following is the uniform policy that begins the first day of school. Uniforms may be purchased online through our school website or from Educational Outfitters (23317 Orchard Lake Rd., Farmington Mi 48336) Please see the school website for a flier.

Preschool and Junior Kindergarten:

Please order your child's school t-shirt online through our website. Preschool and Junior Kindergarten students may wear play clothes with their T-shirts or Sweatshirts with comfortable tennis shoes.

Girls Uniform K-4:

Uniform Jumper: Navy (logo on) or Uniform print

Uniform Skirt or Skort : Navy or Uniform print

Optional Girls Uniform Pant : Navy (*must be purchased from uniform website or Educational Outfitters.*)

Optional -Navy walking shorts (Allowed in September, May and June only)

Shirt: Short or long sleeved white or hunter green polo with St. William Logo. (No other polo colors may be worn) White banded bottom Polo allowed (Educational Outfitters only)

Sweaters: solid white, navy or hunter green.

Socks: must be worn that are ankle length or knee high in white, navy, or hunter green.

Tights: Tights are acceptable in white, navy, or hunter green.

Leggings: Girls may wear uniform leggings that are navy under their jumpers during the cold weather (ONLY). Legging needs to reach the ankle and are not acceptable at calf length.

Shoes: Athletic shoes are acceptable ONLY if they are a solid black, navy or white (NO LOGOS) no exceptions. No glitter or designs of any type. Dress shoes are preferred in solid black, brown, navy or white. Sperry (Boat Shoes) are acceptable in solid colors.

Gym Uniform: All acceptable gym uniform pieces are available on our website. The Gym uniform must be worn on students scheduled gym days only. All shorts and gym pants must have the St. William Logo on them. Combining the uniform skirt or skirt with a gym shirt is not acceptable. Athletic shoes must be worn on gym days.

Hair and accessories: Hair accessories in uniform plaid, navy, forest green, or white are acceptable. No Hair dye of any type is acceptable. No Fad hair styles or cuts are acceptable. No nail polish or tattoos.

Jewelry: Small post earrings are acceptable along with necklaces that contain crosses or religious metals.

Girls Uniform 5-8:

Uniform skirt: uniform plaid ***only***

Shirt: Hunter Green Polo with St. William Logo or White banded bottom Polo (Educational Outfitters only)

Optional Uniform Pant:*(must be purchased from uniform website or Educational Outfitters.)*

Optional -Navy walking shorts (Allowed in September, May and June only)

Sweaters: Solid white, navy, or hunter green.

Socks: must be worn that are ankle length or knee high in white, navy, or hunter green.

Tights: Tights are acceptable in white, navy, or hunter green.

Leggings: Girls may wear uniform leggings that are navy under their skirts during the cold weather (ONLY). Legging needs to reach the ankle and is not acceptable at calf length.

*****8th grade students are allowed to wear their class sweatshirts with their uniform.***

Shoes: Athletic shoes are acceptable ONLY if they are a solid black, navy or white (NO LOGOS) no exceptions. No glitter or designs of any type. Dress shoes are preferred in solid black, brown, navy or white. Sperry (Boat Shoes) are acceptable in solid colors

Gym Uniform: All acceptable gym uniform pieces are available on our website. The Gym uniform must be worn on students scheduled gym days only. All shorts and gym pants must have the St. William Logo on them. **Combining the uniform skirt or uniform pants with a gym shirt is not acceptable.** Athletic shoes must be worn on gym days.

Hair and accessories: Hair accessories in uniform plaid, navy, forest green, or white are acceptable. No Hair dye of any type is acceptable. No Fad hair styles. No nail polish or tattoos.

Jewelry: Small post earrings are acceptable along with necklaces that contain crosses or religious metals.

Boys Uniform K-8:

Pants: Solid Navy Uniform Pants(Must be purchased from the school website or Educational Outfitters)

Shirts: Green or White Polo with the St. William Logo. White banded bottom polo (Available at Educational Outfitters only)

Sweaters: Solid white, navy, or hunter green.

Shorts: Navy walking shorts are optional and worn ONLY in the months of September, May and June.

Socks: Boys may wear navy, white, or black socks that are ankle length.

Shoes: Athletic shoes are acceptable ONLY if they are a solid black, navy or white (NO LOGOS) no exceptions. No designs of any type. Dress shoes are preferred in solid black,brown, navy or white. Sperry (Boat Shoes) are acceptable in solid colors.

*****8th grade students are allowed to wear their class sweatshirts with their uniform.***

Gym Uniform: All acceptable gym uniform pieces are available on our website. The Gym uniform must be worn on students scheduled gym days only. All shorts and gym pants must have the St. William Logo on them. Athletic shoes must be worn on gym days.Combining the navy uniform pants and a gym shirt is not acceptable.

Hair: Hair must be trimmed and worn above the collar. No hair dye of any type is allowed. No tattoos.

Uniform checks will take place throughout the year. Some will be announced with spot checks done by the classroom teachers.
